



PRIVACY POLICY

Optimise Limited (“we”) are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This privacy policy (together with our [website terms of use](#), our [standard terms and conditions](#) and any other documents referred to in them) set out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it. Should there be any inconsistency between this document and our [standard terms and conditions](#), the policies in our [standard terms and conditions](#) shall prevail.

For the purpose of the Data Protection Act 1998 (the **Act**), the data controller is Optimise Limited, and our main trading address is 7/1 London Street, Edinburgh, Midlothian, EH3 6LZ. Our nominated representative for the purpose of the Act is Gordon Forbes, Director, Optimise Limited.

1. Information we may collect from you

1.1 We may collect and process the following data about you:

- (a) information that you provide by filling in forms on our sites www.optimiselimited.co.uk and www.listeningintoaction.co.uk (**our sites**). This includes information provided at the time of registering to use our site, subscribing to our service, posting material or requesting further services; we may also ask you for information when you report a problem with our site;
- (b) if you contact us, we may keep a record of that correspondence;
- (c) we may also ask you to complete surveys that we use for research purposes, although you do not have to respond to them;
- (d) details of transactions you carry out through our site and of the fulfilment of your orders; and
- (e) details of your visits to our site including, but not limited to, traffic data, location data, weblogs and other communication data, whether this is required for our own billing purposes or otherwise, and the resources that you access.

2. IP addresses and cookies

2.1 We may collect information about your computer, including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration and to report aggregate information to our advertisers. This is statistical data about our users' browsing actions and patterns, and does not identify any individual.

2.2 For the same reason, we may obtain information about your general internet usage by using a cookie file which is stored on the hard drive of your computer. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. They help us to improve our site and to deliver a better and more personalised service. They enable us:

- (a) to estimate our audience size and usage pattern;
- (b) to store information about your preferences, and so allow us to customise our site according to your individual interests;
- (c) to speed up your searches; and
- (d) to recognise you when you return to our site.

2.3 You may refuse to accept cookies by activating the setting on your browser which allows you to refuse the setting of cookies; however, if you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of our site. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you log on to our site.

3. Where we store your personal data

3.1 All information you provide to us is stored on our secure servers.

3.2 Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password which enables you to access certain parts of our site, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We ask you not to share a password with anyone.

3.3 Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our site; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorised access.

4. Uses made of the information

4.1 We use information held about you in the following ways:

- (a) to ensure that content from our site is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer;
- (b) to provide you with information, products or services that you request from us or which we feel may interest you, where you have consented to be contacted for such purposes;
- (c) to carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between you and us;
- (d) to allow you to participate in interactive features of our service, when you choose to do so;
- (e) to notify you about changes to our service.

5. Disclosure of your information

5.1 We may disclose your personal information to any member of our group, which means our subsidiaries, our ultimate holding company and its subsidiaries, as defined in section 1261(1) of the UK Companies Act 2006.

5.2 We may disclose your personal information to third parties:

- (a) in the event that we sell or buy any business or assets, in which case we may disclose your personal data to the prospective seller or buyer of such business or assets;
- (b) if we, or substantially all of our assets, are acquired by a third party, personal data held by us about our clients will be one of the transferred assets;
- (c) if we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce or apply our website terms of use and other agreements; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of Optimise Limited, our clients, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

6. Access to information

The Act gives you the right to access information held about you. Your right of access can be exercised in accordance with the Act. Any access request may be subject to a fee of £10 to meet our costs in providing you with details of the information we hold about you.
